LOCAL ECONOMIC IMPACT OF TRANSIT

- \$1 invested = \$4.00 in Return on Investment ¹
- Households near public transit drive an average of 4,400 fewer miles than households with no access to public transit. ¹
- In Atlanta, \$896 is saved per person in a 2-person household using public transit and living with one vehicle. ²

Georgia ranks as the 48th state in per capita investment in transit and provides very little in operating assistance to public transit providers. ³

Our mission is essential to the future health of public transportation in Georgia. Quality of life, environmental concerns, economic development and personal mobility options are issues that can be greatly enhanced in this state by a balanced approach to transportation investment.
